About the Center

The Center for Railroad Photography & Art is a nonprofit arts and educational organization that preserves and presents significant images of railroading, interpreting them in print, on the Internet, and in exhibitions, conferences, and an annual photography contest whose winners' works are, in part, exhibited and published. It is the foremost organization in America for exploring the intersection of railroad art and culture with America's history and culture. Our 2010 "Conversations about Photography" conference has been called the "best ever." The April 2011 conference continues on the campus of co-sponsor Lake Forest (Illinois) College, our archival partner.

Recent Activities

Two well-received publications appeared in 2009: the print edition of North American Railroad History in a Nutshell and *Classic Steam*, a book for Barnes & Noble created in association with the Center and written and compiled by John Gruber. Consider buying both for the students in your families. The Center is working in conjunction with a Chicago museum on a significant exhibition of Jack Delano's 1942-43 railroad photographs. Concentrating on portraits of Chicago-area workers, the exhibition will include their stories and the stories of their families, demonstrating that it took the work of many men and women from all ethnic backgrounds to keep America's principal industry humming. Without railroads, there would be no modern industry. And, we are showing the work of new, young, or relatively unknown railroad photographers on our web site, railphoto-art.org.
